



Dixie Youth World Series
Tiger Walk – 6:45 p.m.
Auburn University

Immediately following the opening dinner, members of the Auburn University Marching Band will lead the World Series Tiger Walk out through the back of Jordan Hare Stadium. The World Series Tiger Walk will begin at Jordan Hare Stadium and end at Samford Stadium at Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park. The World Series Tiger Walk will be followed by the Opening Ceremonies, which will begin at 7:30 p.m.

Tiger Walk is an Auburn tradition which began in the early 1960s when Auburn players would walk from Sewell Hall to the football stadium and fans would line Donahue Drive to wish them well. Over the years, the Tiger Walk has grown into a major part of game day at Auburn, so much so that it is listed on the players' game weekend itinerary. The largest Tiger Walk is believed to have taken place prior to the 1989 Alabama game when more than 20,000 well wishers lined the street. Every Tiger Walk prior to home football games draws thousands of fans. Over the last couple of years, the Tiger Walk has become a standard and tradition as Auburn football players enter the stadium before the game. We are excited to share the Tiger Walk tradition with Dixie Youth Baseball.
